Common signs of forced labour are:

- Forced to work for little or no pay
- · Employer is withholding identity documents
- · Job is different than what was promised
- · Living conditions are substandard or dangerous
- · Shows signs of abuse, malnourished, poor personal hygiene
- · Fearful, anxious, isolated
- · Restricted movement, being controlled
- · Forced to repay a debt and/or illegal recruitment fee
